<p>Tops</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Short sleeved or long sleeved solid white, navy blue, or black colored polo shirt with collar and 2-3 buttons. NO logos allowed <u>unless</u> it is a JSAA logo.• Any color/style shirt or t-shirt may be worn UNDER the polo shirt.• No coats or windbreakers are allowed inside the classroom; the student must leave those items in their lockers.• Solid navy blue, black or white sweaters or sweatshirts/hoodies with NO logos can be worn inside the classroom (unless the item was purchased as JSAA Spirit Wear).• Uniform shirts must always be worn under sweaters, sweatshirts or hoodies.• No oversized or undersized clothing is allowed!	<p>Bottoms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Solid navy blue, khaki, or black slacks. Slacks should be plain, have buttons or a zipper and working back pockets.• Shorts or skirts in the above uniform colors may be worn with a length that reaches the knees, while keeping the waistline at the waist. Length must be to the knee, touching the kneecap or longer. Capri pants may also be worn.• No sweat pants, gym shorts, jeans or leggings/jeggings are allowed.• Leggings can only be worn under a dress or skirt and must be solid navy blue, khaki, black or white. No multi-colored leggings or leggings that look like jeans!• Sagging is not allowed! Bottoms must be fitted and worn at the waistline. No oversized or undersized clothing is allowed!
<p>Footwear</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No flip-flops or sports slippers.• No house/bedroom slippers. <p>Belts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Belts must be worn above the hip bone. <u>No Sagging!</u>• Buckles must be plain and functional.• Belts must go through all loops and not have a remainder greater than what can slide through the belt loops.	<p>Miscellaneous Items</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No hats or other head coverings are allowed in the building. Simple, solid colored headbands are allowed. No bandanas.• No backpacks, bags or purses are allowed in the classrooms. They must be left in locker.• No outer coats or gloves are allowed in classrooms.• No headphones. If headphones are used in class for instruction, they must be put away after classroom use.• No sunglasses or non-prescription glasses or frames.• Cell phones and electronic devices should be left at home; if brought to school, they should be left in the locker. These items will be confiscated if seen during school hours (8am – 4pm). <u>JSAA will not be responsible for lost or stolen cell phones or electronic devices.</u>
